

CLOSING REPORT | DEERWALK SIFAL NIGHT MAHOTSAV 1.0



Executive Summary

Deerwalk Sifal Night Mahotsav 1.0 [2023] was held at Nepal Academy Hall showcasing student's participation in cultural programs and talent shows with their artistic endeavors. The Mahotsav 1.0 featured a diverse range of performances and interactive activities setting an indelible mark on the history of Sifal School.

Sifal School organized 'Deerwalk Sifal Night Mahotsav 1.0' on the 3rd of Poush, 2080 (19 December, 2023). The primary objective of the event was to provide a good platform to the students for showcasing their engagement extracurricular attempts and their talents in diverse activities. The event sought to foster a vibrant sense of community among the school family. This marked the first step in organizing such a grand event of the school outside of its premises. Sifal School had sent invitation letters to all the parents for their presence at the 'Deerwalk Sifal Night Mahotsav 1.0'. Sifal School had booked the hall for an entire day of 3rd Poush, to ensure a coordinated event. All the students were motivated to participate and showcase their talents. Their engagement, and excitement led the program to a level of excellence. The program was completely led by the ECA Club Presidents, and the CR's of the High School.

For the Mahotsav, the school had formulated certain rules and regulations regarding the registration procedure and the event flow. Several meetings were held regarding the event, and numerous rehearsals were taken beforehand. The excitement of the students added a magical touch to the entire event.

On the 3rd of Poush, the students and the staff members reached the hall early at 10:00 am. The staff members there were really helpful there, and they assisted us to put on the banners and fix the lighting of the event. A final rehearsal took place in the hall from 11:00 am, leaving all the students well prepared to present their talents to their curious audience. The registration process formally began at 2:30 am. All the students volunteered eagerly to ensure the smooth flow of the event.

Confirming to the schedule, the event finally kick started at 3:00 am, with the rendition of the national anthem. Smoothly, each event took place and the parents were very happy to see their children on the stage. Sifal School had also arranged for a short snack break for refreshment, with a well-prepared food court. Before the short snack break, dance performances, yoga

performances, dramas took place, while after the short snack break, a diverse array of musical performances took place.

In the second part of the program in the evening, 'Ko bhanda Ko Kam', a magnificent musical and dance performance was held completely led by grade XII students, showcasing their talents which gave the event a unique and vibrant energy, leaving a lasting impression on the parents and the audience. This performance was a sort of competition among the three Grade XII sections: Lobuche, Khumbila, and Yala. Three judges gave their judgment and handed the winner section name to Mr. Nirmal Kumar Poudel, the Vice Principal, for administrative affairs, who was also the emcee for the 'Ko Bhanda Ko Kam' program. Mr. Bijaya Kumar Shrestha, the Principal of Sifal School was invited to the stage to handover the trophies and prizes to the winners. It turned out to be 'Khumbila' as best performer of the event for both music and dance categories. Finally, a closing note by Mr. Ujjwal Poudel, the Vice Principal of Academic Affairs formally marked the ending of this memorable event.
