Executive Summary

Each semester, students at Sifal School perform a variety of extracurricular activities they have learned in front of their parents, guardians, and teachers. One example of the school's culture of reading, writing, and demonstration is the Deerwalk Sifal Night.

Sifal School organized "Deerwalk Sifal Night" for grades 1 and 2, Elementary School, on Mangsir 2, 2079 (November 18, 2022). In Deerwalk Sifal Night, students demonstrate the various performing arts they have learned in the academic year 2079. It occurs over the course of three months each year. Students from Grades I to II performed Dance, Music, Drama, Yoga and Meditation, Visual Art, and ITF in front of their parents, guardians, and teachers.

The program started at 4:45 PM with an emcee introduction by Ms. Novita Rai, English Language Department Educator, and the evening assembly with the National Anthem and Shanti Mantra, followed by the welcome speech by Ms. Sarina Maharjan, Faculty Member. She conveyed the important message of the four pillars of schooling at DSS, i.e., Academic Fundamentals, Essential Skills, ECAs, and Language Skills. The speech marked the end of the formal session.
