Executive Summary

Sifal School conducted a promising event called 'Deerwalk Sifal Night' where the students demonstrated their skills and knowledge of Extra Curricular Activities they learned in school.

Sifal School hosted a 'Deerwalk Sifal Night' for Elementary School on Shrawan 12, 2080 and Shrawan 19, 2080 for Grade levels I-II and III- IV respectively. Students displayed knowledge of various performing arts they had learned. The students performed dance, music, drama, visual arts, ITF, yog and poetry in front of their parents, guardians, and teachers.

The program started at 4:45 PM with an emcee introduction by Mrs. Ankita Pokharel and Mrs. Hama Rajbhandari for the Lower and Upper Elementary level respectively and with the National Anthem and Shanti Mantra, followed by the welcome speech by Mrs. Manisha Adhikari and Mrs. Chanda Pandey for the Lower Elementary and Upper Elementary respectively. Program Overview
