## Executive Summary

*Sifal School organizes the varied event to enhance and learn between the students of different schools by showcasing their hidden talents. With the same, Sifal School organized 'Inter School Poem Competition 2080' for sharing the competency of the literacy skills in the form of poetry from the different schools within and out of Kathmandu Valley.*

Sifal School organized the 'Inter School Poetry Competition 2080' on Bhadra 2nd 2080 (August 19, 2023). This was the first inter school event in the history of Sifal School. School organizes such events to exhibit poetic expression of the diverse participants. Poetry is a form of literature that promotes literacy and builds self-awareness, social awareness and emotional resilience in students. Reciting poetry helps focus on the sound and rhythm of speech, thereby building students' phonemic awareness, encouraging creative writing, and laying the foundation for reading abilities. Responsibility of judgment was handed to two external guests and the Nepali language teacher. The event was coordinated by Tej Prasad Kafle, the Head of Nepali Department. In the grand finale, there were 57 finalists - 52 present participants from schools took part in the program. The title first place was earned by Utshav Dhungana and second position by Rajan Wagle both from Sanskrit Secondary School (Durbar High School Ranipokhari), and third position by Sneha Poudel from Awareness International Academy (AIA), Sankhamul, Kathmandu. They were awarded medals and certificates by the Principal and Vice principals respectively.

In short, the audience, including parents and guardians, enjoyed all the performances. The participants shared their poem on different themes such as time, culture, mosquito, technology and father. The efforts and coordination of faculty, students, support staff and administrators, as well as the support of parents, made the event a huge success. The students' performance at the event made the parents and teachers proud.

## Program Schedule

## Program Overview

Sifal School hosted Inter School Poem Competition - 2080 on Bhadra 2, 2080 (August 19, 2023). The venue was at Sagarmatha Hall of Deerwalk Complex and the registration time was from 10:00 A.M to 10:45 A.M. More than 200 people attended the event. The event had two sessions, Formal and Poetry Session.

## Formal Session

Students from the class of 2028 Prasanna Dhungel and Anushree Acharya hosted the event. The event began with the national anthem, with all attendees standing to sing and showing respect for the country. A few students from grade V and VI recited the Shanti mantra which filled the hall with a peaceful aura. A welcome note by Mr. Youbraj Aryal, faculty member of the Nepali department, followed this. He delivered a warm welcome speech highlighting the practicality of the school's literacy culture. After that, the emcees called the participants to take their places in the order of their lottery. They also introduced the judges namely Mr. Ananta Wagle (Storywriter and Poet), Ms. Laxmi Tiwari (Faculty Member of the Nepali Department), and Mr. Ram Babu Subedi (Renowned poet). The emcees invited the first participant on stage and the poetry session began.

## Poetry Session

Poetry session began with inviting judges to take their respective seats at the left of the stage arranged beforehand. Fifty-eight participants had marked their position as finalists altogether. The emcees called the names of all the participants.

Principal to distribute medals and certificates to the winners. The first position was bagged by, Utshav Dhungana, and second position by Rajan Wagle from both Sanskrit Secondary School (Durbar High School Ranipokhari) and third position by Sneha Poudel from Awareness International Academy (AIA), Sankhamul, Kathmandu. Youba Raj Aryal, Faculty of Nepali Department made a keynote speech, highlighting on importance of poetry and thanked all the students and schools for participating.

After the end of the program, all the participants, guiding teachers and faculties gathered on canteen courtyard and made a photo session. Then the group photo session was completed. The entire participant took part in refreshment in canteen and program concluded.
