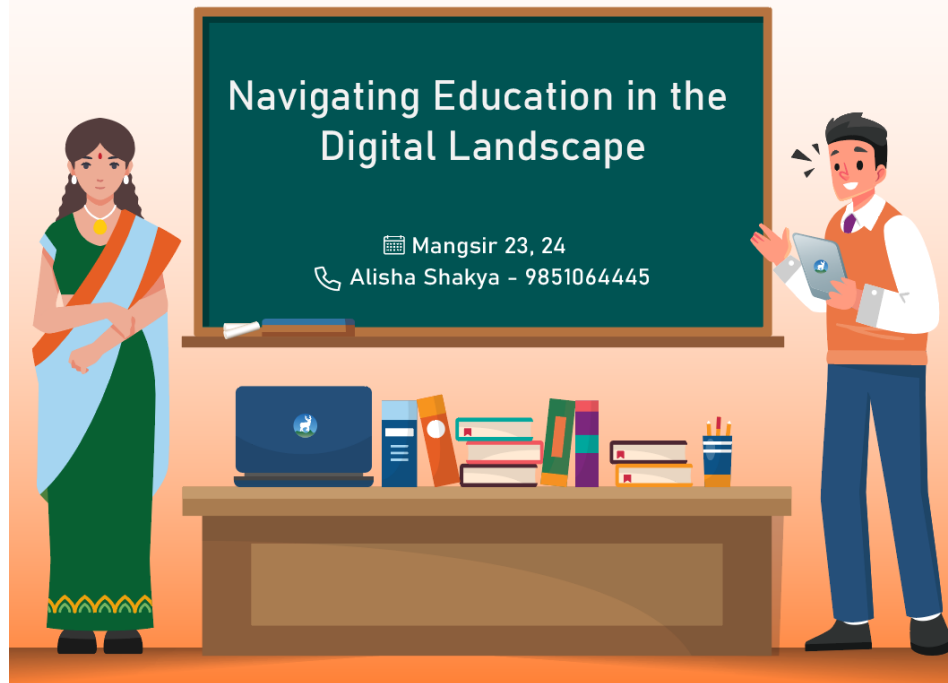

CLOSING REPORT - TEACHERS TOGETHER - 2080



Executive Summary

Sifal School conducted the fourth ‘Teachers Together - 2080’ on 23rd Mangsir, 2080, (9th December, 2023) at the deerwalk complex. The mission of the event is to bring teachers from multiple backgrounds in one place to share knowledge and grow. This year’s theme was, “Navigating Education in The Digital Landscape”, where the main focus was on pre-primary and primary teachers.

There were four workshops: Coding; conducted by Kusal Maharjan and Santosh Kumar Sahu, Google Workspace (Forms); conducted by Madhu Sudhan Bhusal and Sagina Maharjan, Social Media Management (LinkedIn); conducted by Aakanchya Thapa and Sharad Sharma and AI and Machine Learning (Intelligence & Chat GPT); conducted by Manoj Shakya. Each session was an hour and a half long. There were altogether 107 participants from different institutions of Kathmandu valley.

The teachers had to confirm their registration at the desk, after the confirmation they got a registration bag which included course outline, class schedule, diary, pen and conference card. The teachers were provided welcome tea alongside a hearty breakfast. Then, they gathered at Sagarmatha hall for the orientation session where, Ms. Alisha Shakya (Administration Department) delivered a welcome speech. The event’s emcee Ms. Ankita Pokharel (Faculty member of English department) invited Mr. Bijaya K. Shrestha (Principal), he divided the participants into three groups: Khainjadi, Yalamber and Ektare.

The teachers were guided to their respective training rooms by faculty members of the Elementary School, Ms. Anjali Gurung, Ms. Sarina Maharjan, Ms. Bidhya Karki, Ms. Sushila Kafle, Ms. Bindu Paudel, Ms. Chanda Pandey, Ms. Hama Rajbhandari, Ms. Sindhu Paudel and Ms. Manisha Adhikari respectively. The session began at 10 AM and after two sessions there was a lunch break at 1 PM – 2 PM. After which, the session resumed and ended at 5 PM.

All the teachers had gathered at Sagarmatha hall for the final workshop of AI and Machine Learning. After the session ended, the closing note was delivered by Bijaya K. Shrestha – he emphasized the importance of teachers in an educational institution and the gravity of empowering them. Then, the emcee called the names of the participants to receive the certificate of completion which was distributed by Mr. Nirmal K. Paudel (Vice Principal of Administrative Affairs) and Mr.

Ujjwal Poudel (Vice Principal of Academic Affairs) respectively. Continuing on, Bijaya Shrestha was once again called on stage to distribute the certificate of gratitude to the trainers.

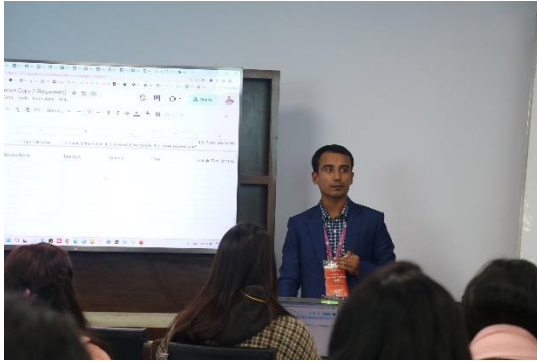

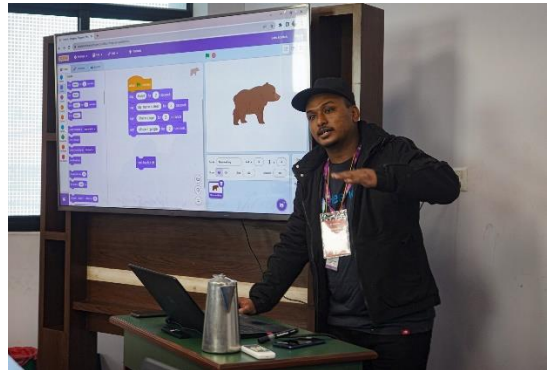
