



Survey Report | Teachers' Knowledge Sharing Session, 2079

Program Overview

The session featured 8 experienced presenters who delivered engaging presentations on various topics relevant to the teaching profession. The presentations covered a wide range of subjects and topics including classroom management, integrated learning, phonetics and more. The presenters incorporated interactive activities, real-life examples, and group discussions to enhance participant engagement and learning.

A total of 35 teachers actively participated in the knowledge sharing session. The participants represented different grade levels and subject areas, creating a diverse learning environment. Key Findings of Survey Report

This report is the findings of the survey conducted after the recent teachers' knowledge sharing session. A total of 20 teachers participated in the survey. The purpose of the survey was to gather feedback from the participants and evaluate the effectiveness of the session. Here are the key findings:

1. Participation

- 40 % of the respondents were from Elementary School
- 35 % respondents were from High School while 25 % were from Middle School.

2. Overall Satisfaction

- 85 % of the respondents expressed satisfaction with the knowledge Sharing Session.
- 10 % rated the session as “Exceeded Expectations” while 5 % rated it as neutral.

3. Relevance and Content:

- 65 % of the respondents found the content of the session highly relevant to their teaching practice.
- 30 % felt that the session covered a wide range of topics and addressed their professional development needs effectively.

4. Presenter's Knowledge and Delivery:

- 75 % acknowledged the presenter's expertise and knowledge on the subject matter.
- 20 % strongly appreciated the presenter's engaging and interactive delivery style while 5 % rated as neutral

5. Learning Outcomes:

- 80 % of the participants reported that they gained new knowledge and skills from the session.
- 15 % of the participants felt that the session provided them with practical strategies and tools that can be implemented in their classrooms.

6. Suggestions for Improvement:

- Some participants suggested incorporating more hands-on activities for better understanding.
- Others recommended sessions on regular basis to boost up the coordination, and cooperation among colleague.
- Some participants felt that the presenter should be clearer on the topic he / she is presenting

Learning Outcomes

1. The information presented throughout the presentations gave educators useful tips and cutting-edge methods to use in the classroom.
2. The session promoted networking possibilities, enabling educators to get to know one another, share ideas, and forge prospective partnerships. The networking component was praised by the participants for giving them access to a wider network of professional allies.
3. For the teachers, the workshop was a source of motivation and inspiration. Participants were inspired to pursue greatness and continue their professional growth by the presenters' personal experiences and success stories.

Recommendations

Based on the feedback received from participants, a few recommendations have been made for future knowledge sharing sessions

1. Provide sessions that are targeted to particular subject areas or grade levels to ensure that the content is focused and appropriate.
2. Increase the session's time to allow for more thorough discussions and the application of concepts in real-world situations.
3. Incorporate more hands-on activities and interactive workshops to further engage participants.

Conclusion

During the Knowledge Sharing session teachers were successfully given a comprehensive platform to share knowledge, develop insights, and improve their professional practices. The participants' feedbacks demonstrate how successful these sessions are at promoting professional development and teamwork among the teachers.

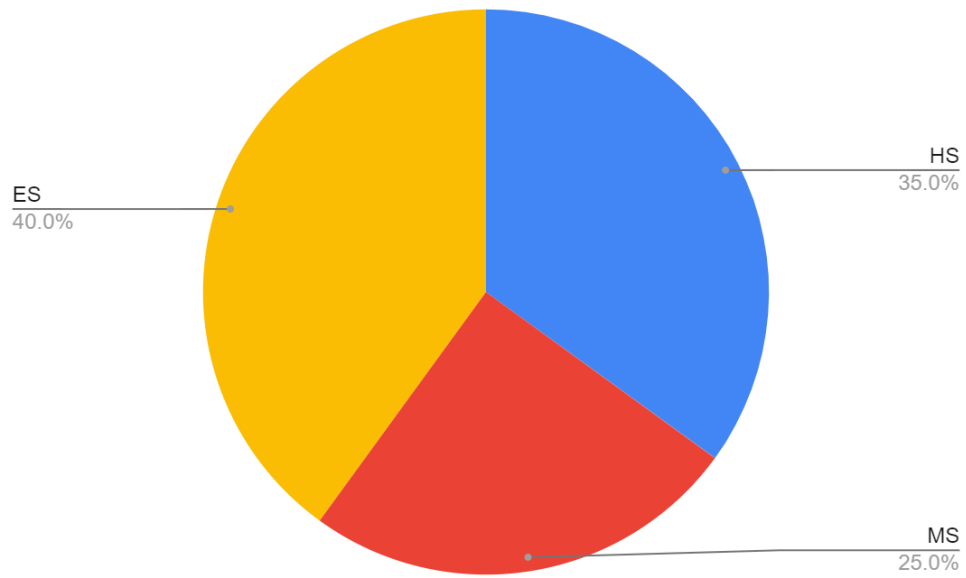

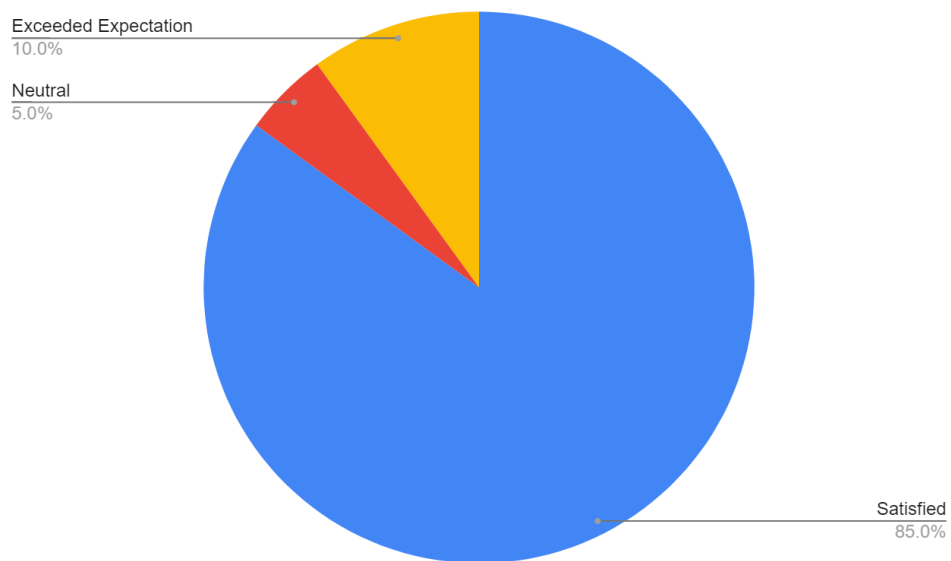

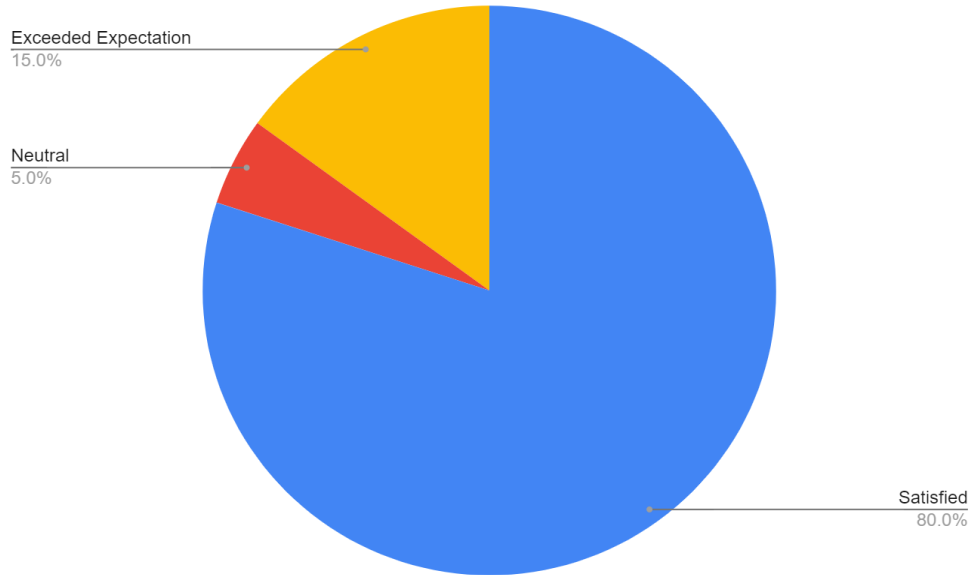
1. From which school level did you attend the session?



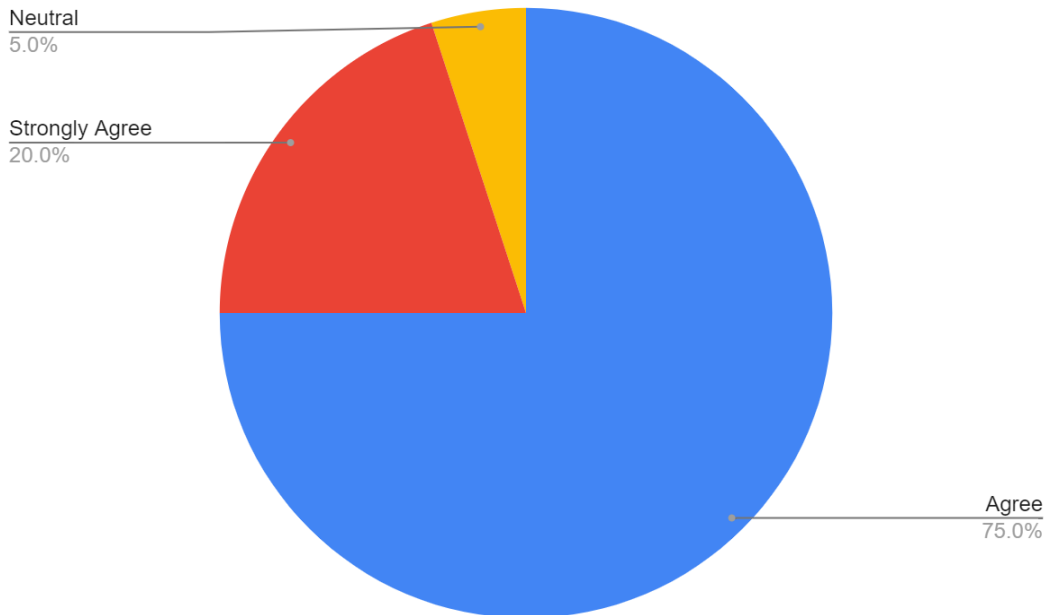
2. What is your overall assessment of the session?



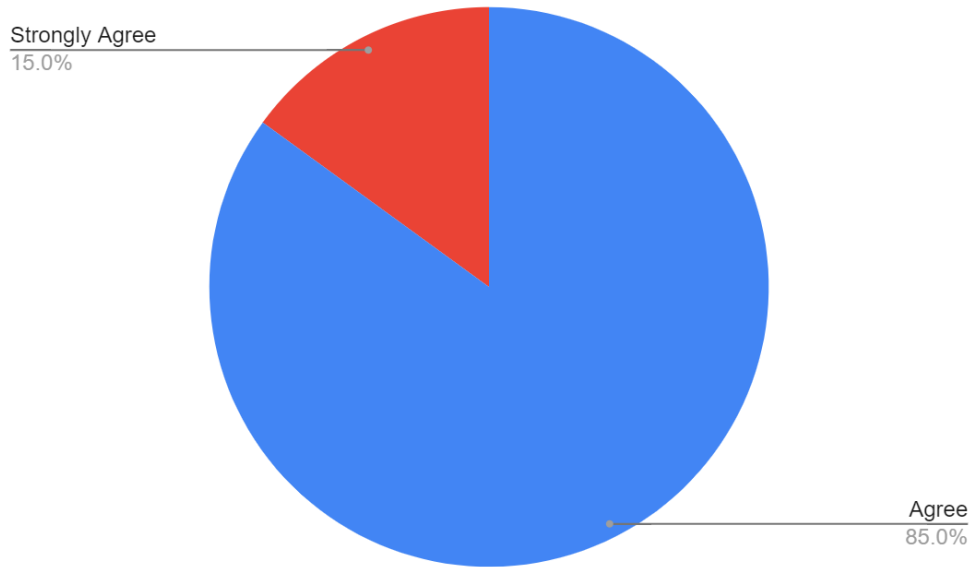
3. How would you rate the workshop when comes to the achievement of the program objectives?



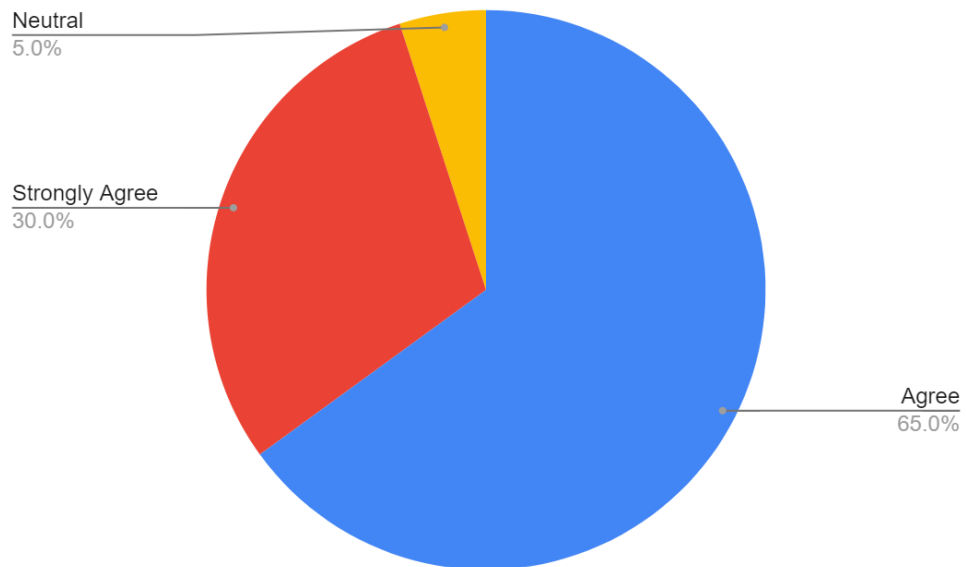
4. The presenter was able to explain things clearly



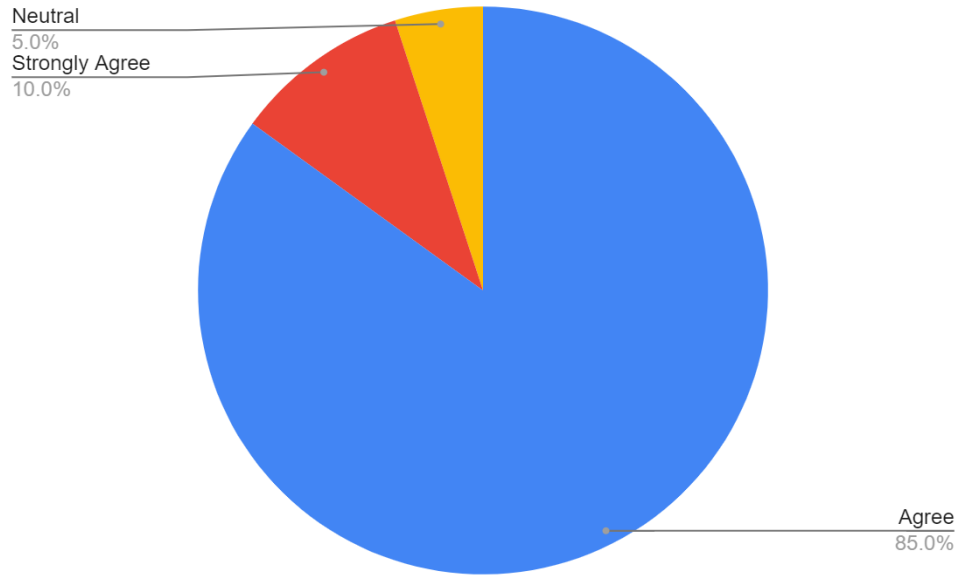
5. The workshop was interesting



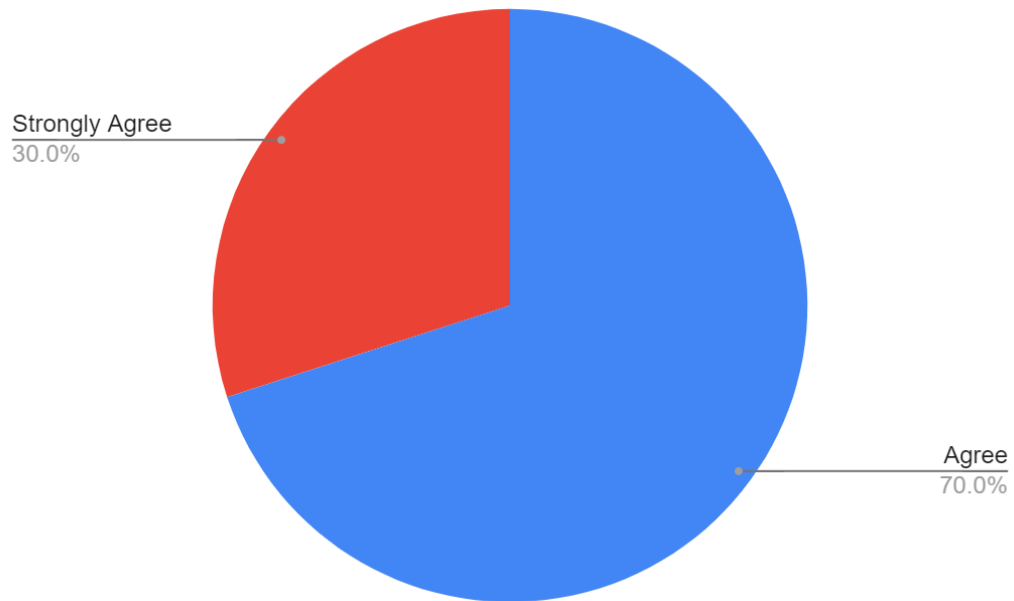
6. The workshop got people involved and interacting
