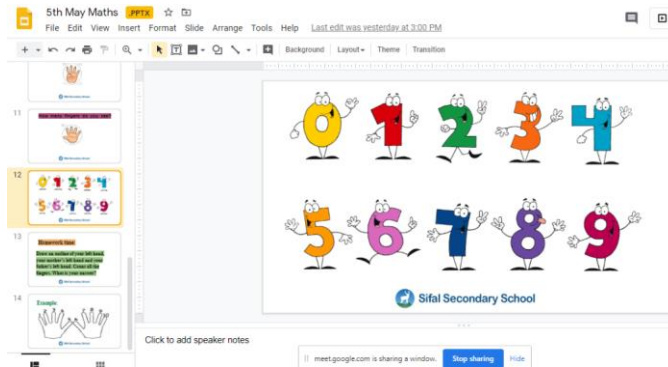


Result Distribution | Term III, 2076

In the second week of Baishakh, 2077, Sifal School published the results of the Final Terminal Examination of the academic year 2076 for Grade 1-7 and 9. The soft-copy of the mark sheets were emailed to the parents. The parents can collect the hard copies once the nationwide lockdown due to COVID-19 gets over.

Study From Home

Sifal School started the Academic Year 2077 from Baishakh 15. Amid the nationwide lockdown to fight against COVID-19, the school started the 'Study from Home' program by running the effective online classes for all grades from the very day. From Jestha 1, the school is running three periods of the online class a day for each grade.



Likewise, the school has shared the video lectures and other study materials to all students and/or their parents so that the students can continue their learning. The video lectures from Grade 4-12 are prepared by our teachers at Deerwalk Learning Center.

Creative Writing

In this lockdown period, DSS students are making good use of their time in writing. At home, they can write on any topic they want and send the articles to the teachers. The articles are then published on the online placeholders of the school. Enhancing the writing skills of the students is one of the focuses of Sifal School.

Now, with the collaboration with DishHome, DLC expects a wide outreach of the video lectures (~10% of the country's population!). School magazine - The Deerwalker

Sifal School has released the fifth issue of the school magazine, The Deerwalker. The magazine is a student-run and led magazine and is published quarterly by the 'The Deerwalker' club. In this issue, the students have focussed more on comprehensive writing. The co-editor-in-chief, Rusha Manandhar (Grade 10), welcomes the readers with a note, 'As said by Victor Hugo, "He, who opens a school door, closes a prison". Read aloud - Podcast

In this lockdown period, the school has started an initiative – making read-aloud podcast videos. Students from Lower School (Grade 1-3) read the storybooks and send the audio files. Digital Media Lab renders those audio files to make the podcast videos. Reading out loud, which the school encourages to its students, is known to boost children's vocabulary.
