
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Field Visit - Middle School

Sifal School organized the Field Visit for Grade 4-8 students on Asar 14 and Asar 28. In the program, the students had a virtual tour of the Smithsonian National Museum of Natural History, Washington D.C., USA (https://naturalhistory.si.edu/). The students observed the exhibits of a large collection of specimens of animals, including the fossils of the extinct animals.



Physiotherapy Session

On Asar 14, students from Lower School (Grade 1-3) attended the virtual training session on Physiotherapy. They were trained in various techniques that decrease the side effects of continuous sitting posture and screen time. The students were encouraged to practice these techniques during the break time of the online classes.
