At DSS, students have to read one Nepali and one English fiction novels/storybooks every month.


#### **Field Visit | Second Term**

For Lower School (Grade 1-3), it was organized on Ashwin 13 where the students observed several historical videos and pictures related to 'Ancient Kathmandu.'


