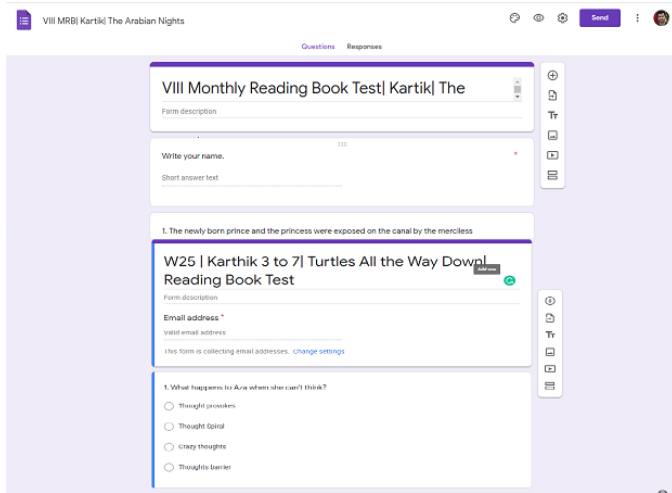


Reading Book Grading | Kartik

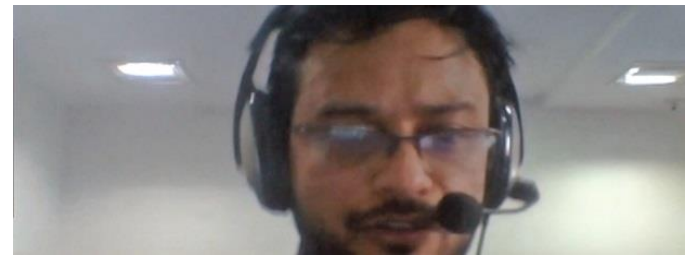


Book Talk | HS

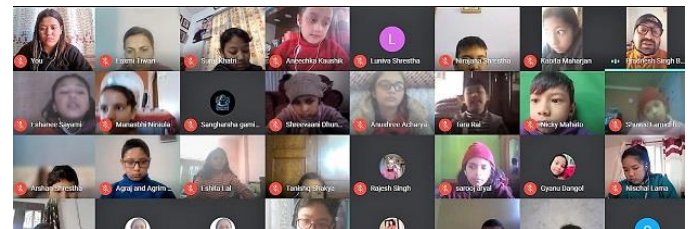
Students took part with great zeal and learnt a great deal hearing from his experience.

Parent's Talk | MS

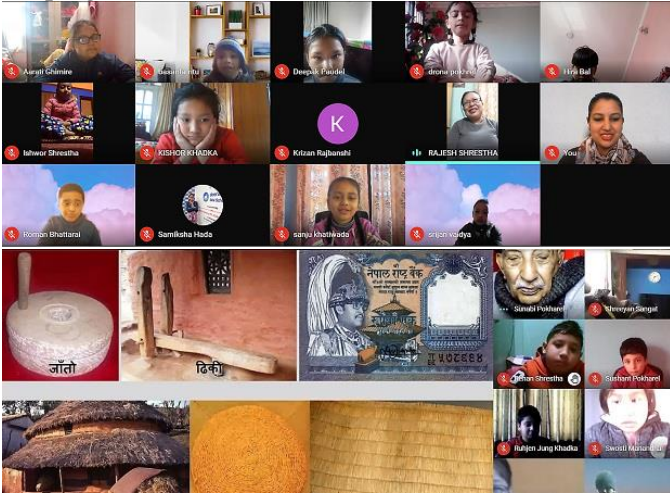
