
Monthly Test | Term III




Field Visit | Term III






Second Term Result

In this talk, Jeff gave a brief introduction to CERN, and discussed the potential scenarios for the future of particle physics. Also, he oriented our students about the various educational offers and opportunities to interact with CERN.

CERN is one of the world's largest centers for fundamental scientific research. Located in Geneva on

the border between France and Switzerland, it brings together more than 20,000 people from around the world to

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tackle the fundamental questions of particle physics. Among its recent success stories is the discovery of the

Higgs boson that confirmed the existence of the so-called Brout-Englert-Higgs mechanism that gives mass to elementary particles. Indeed, fundamental research is CERN's primary mission, but the Laboratory also plays a vital role in developing new technologies, such as the world wide web.

AGM-2077 | DSS

The Annual General Meetings of Deerwalk Group Limited (DWG), Sifal School Limited (DSS), and Deerwalk Compware Limited (DWC) were held on Chaitra 14, 2077 at Sagarmatha Hall. Several presentations were made regarding the new initiatives these companies have taken followed by discussions from all the promoters as to how to take the organization forward in days to come.

Some of the major resolution passed unanimously are:

1. Raise the company's authorized capital to NRs. 70 crores.
2. Issue 100% right shares to raise about NRs 24.5 crores to build the new infrastructure.
3. Give authority to the company's board to change management and minor company regulations on as/when needed basis without shareholders' meetings.

Also informed promoters that at next AGM, the board will propose to allow employees to buy company share at par value to increase employee ownership. The board will propose the right amount of shares for employee ownership every year.
